**Premium Dispensing Machine for Pachinko Parlors with an industry's first strict management function**

- A great help in stricter and more efficient parlor operation -

GLORY has developed the "JK-300" premium dispensing machine that is used to exchange pachinko balls won by players with premiums, and will release this new model on October 20, 2010.

In pachinko parlors, players (customers), after playing pachinko, exchange their balls with premiums in proportion to the number of balls. Some premiums are expensive, sometimes made of precious metal, and contained in card cases. Due to their value, staff members of pachinko parlors have to control pricey premiums under mental pressure. To alleviate such condition, GLORY developed in 1990, for the first time in the industry, a premium dispensing machine to dispense the required number of premiums depending on the quantity of balls in cooperation with a premium management terminal. Since then GLORY developed various peripheral products for pachinko parlors such as pachinko ball dispensers and counters to contribute to more efficient and stricter operation of pachinko parlors.

GLORY has developed the "JK-300" premium dispensing machine, an epoch-making product, which is capable of the following three functions for the first time in the industry.

1. A count sensor automatically counts the number of premiums stored in the machine in about 30 seconds. This eliminates tedious jobs of manual recounting of premiums in the machine at the end of shifts or at the close of business.
2. When the machine is replenished with premiums, the sensor automatically monitors the colors of the premiums to make sure that they are properly stored in designated cassettes according to their colors, thus eliminating errors in refilling operations.
3. To operate the machine, it is necessary for every operator to hold his/her ID card over the scanner, thus making it possible to record a history of who did what operation and when.

These new functions help greatly improve the strictness and efficiency in premium management operation. GLORY is committed to further focusing on the development of new products to serve customer needs.
