Newly-developed Multi-functional Cash Management Station, DSR-200, for Retail Stores

- Enabling low-cost operation by eliminating dedicated operators (open to every operator) for cash processing -

GLORY has developed a multi-functional cash management station, DSR-200 to be marketed in mid-July, that can manage proceeds of supermarkets and similar retail stores. This new model was exhibited in the “Retail Tech JAPAN 2011” that was held from March 8 at Tokyo Big Sight.

[Summary]

Main features:

- Works as both a sales proceeds acceptor and a change dispenser in supermarkets and similar retail stores.
- Manages operators by validating them with ID cards, eliminating the necessity of dedicated operators.
- Enables rolled coins to be loaded and dispensed; a large quantity of coins can be stored in a small space.

There are multiple cash registers in a retail store such as supermarket. A cash register contains sales proceeds and change that are counted after the close of business. In some stores, dedicated staff members would settle up the cash in cash registers. In recent years, for the purpose of efficiency, an increasing number of stores begin introducing sales proceeds deposit machines that allow cashiers to deposit cash by him/herself without relying on dedicated operators. The deposited cash is sent to financial institutions by cash-in-transit service providers.

Due to changing trends in the market, the number of smaller retail stores has been increasing lately. Because such stores do not have many employees, they cannot afford to employ dedicated operators. Also, they tend to be forced to streamline their workflow to reduce costs.

The newly-developed DSR-200 is a multi-functional cash management station for retail stores that can work as a sales proceeds acceptor as well as a change dispenser. Because cash of sales proceeds that have been collected from registers can be used as change again, money can be effectively managed by using the DSR-200 station.

The DSR-200 can be replenished with rolled coins, for use as change, that are delivered by a cash-in-transit service provider. This function makes it possible to use rolled coins for dispensing coins and for the purpose of money change, providing more efficient operation when compared with loose coins. This model can also accept and dispense 10,000 yen banknotes, allowing usage of 10,000 yen notes in various scenes of store operations.

The DSR-200 can work more effectively when it is used in combination with GLORY’s coin and banknote recyclers and rolled coin management system. GLORY intends to achieve linkage of cash inventory data in those machines and more effective cash management in retail stores.

GLORY aims at extending our share of products for the retail market by proposing innovative products, including the DSR-200, to realize more efficient and stricter cash management in connection with cash registers and backyard operations.
