GLORY will implement the TABLE FOR TWO PROGRAM
- Company cafeteria supports employees' social action and health control -

From July 29, 2011, GLORY will start serving, in its headquarters' cafeteria, the meals supporting the TABLE FOR TWO ("TFT") program which allows part of the food prices to be used for donation.

TFT is a social contribution program run by a non-profit organization, Table for Two International, based on the concept that people in the developed countries and children in developing countries share meals beyond time and space.

It is said that in our world of almost 7 billion, 1 billion suffer from hunger and malnutrition, while an equal number face obesity, diabetes, and other health issues. TFT program is designed to right this imbalance by simultaneously addressing two opposing problems with a simple meal; the idea is that every 20 yen of the price of nutritionally balanced TFT branded meal you eat at a cafeteria is used to provide school meals in developing countries. Twenty yen is roughly how much it costs for one school meal in a developing country.

Having considered that the TFT program will provide GLORY employees with an opportunity to participate in a social action and at the same time give attention to their own health control, GLORY has decided to implement the program in the cafeteria of its headquarters in Himeji.

(Implementation details)

One of the dishes to be served as "TFT menu" on the second and fourth Fridays (50 dishes per day).
